1984 has come and gone, and with it the first twenty five years in the history of the college. The College Board has been pleased to have been associated with the celebration of this note-worthy occasion.

During this time of celebration, traditions built up over the period are recalled and sometimes reviewed. One such tradition to be reviewed was the school tie, and it was finally agreed to make it an optional part of the school uniform. To some this represented a backward step, a lowering of standards, a break with tradition. To others it represented a uniform more in keeping with the relaxed style of dress of today.

The important thing is that the decision should prove in the long term, not to be detrimental to the school spirit, both within the school community and the wider general community. Too often a move such as this is seen as a victory for the liberals, and a defeat for the conservatives, whereas the real test is whether or not the school's image has been damaged in the eyes of the pupils or the community. The Board will be extremely disappointed if pupils, through their attitudes to their school uniform, present a picture to the general community, of total disregard for their school image.

Board members are well aware that the uniform is only one of the things that contribute to the community's general impression of the school, and needs to be looked at in this perspective. However, it can be seen by some as a further lowering of standards; what will be the next target, and what benefit has accrued to the school.

It is to be hoped that time does not prove these people to be correct. The onus is fairly and squarely on the total school community to see that this does not happen.

PRINCIPAL'S COMMENTS

At the end of the silver jubilee year, there is much for which we can be grateful. The response of those who have been through the college was particularly encouraging and gave us much food for reflection. The college has been in existence for twenty five years and is now on its way towards the half century. Without doubt the next twenty five years will be very different. In looking back, it is possible to recall the struggle that was involved in establishing the college and ensuring that it was set on a firm foundation. In looking forward it is possible to see that a struggle will still be there, this time to ensure that the college remains true to the call of the Church.

At this present time, the Catholic school is under pressure from within the Church and from without. Unfortunately, there are many erroneous statements being made about what has happened to Catholic schools since integration. There have been changes, there have been improvements, there have been mistakes and there have been some conflicts. In all this, however, I believe Catholic schools have a right to the truth about what has happened. There is room for disagreement, there is room for opposition, but I do not believe there is room for the spreading of false information. There have been instances in the past year when statements have circulated among people within our catchment area, which are quite false. Statements with regard to both primary and secondary schools. If we believe in the value of Catholic schools then, I believe, there is a responsibility on each of us to challenge these false statements.

Given the questioning of Catholic schools that is coming from within the Catholic community, it may be well to consider once again, whether the Catholic school has value. In order to claim to be Catholic, the school must be seeking to create an environment where the values of Jesus of Nazareth are evident. The Good News he brought must be central. At the heart of the Good News, is the assertion that God is love and is for us. Jesus experienced

God as Abba, 'daddy', and himself as Son. It was this experience he wished to share with others and to draw them into a similar awareness. He was able to link the mystery of God with the question rising in the hearts of the common man and woman. He showed people that they had meaning for him. When Jesus loved them, they knew that God loved them, without condition or limit or time or place or person. He showed them that despite everything, there is hope. He encouraged them to abide in love, even if this love does not seem to get anywhere and is vain; believe in this vain love, he said, and exist for others. That was his central message and that is what should be at the centre of the Catholic school.

The Catholic educator must be committed to the task of forming men and women who will make the 'civilisation of love' a reality. The experience of being nurtured in love must ground everything in a Catholic school. In saying this, however, it is crucial to accept that the school is not the home, it is not the parish church, it is not a hospital. It is a school.

As a school, we must be clear about the purpose for which we exist. We must be clear that the manner in which everything is done here should be after the manner of Jesus, and life at the school should be an experience of the Good News. We should not be a place where pre-formulated answers are dished out. We should not be a place with all the answers. Instead, we need to acknowledge that we do not have all the answers. What we need is to be filled with confidence that the Lord is with us and loves the people involved here. Hence





the journey we are on, while full of risks, is a journey of love. Our confidence is based not on the fact that we have all the answers, but on who walks with us. We are searching together for what the Good News is for us today. We are looking at what Jesus would mean for us to be fully human today.

What we say in a Catholic school must give an answer which applies to everyone. The Good News Jesus brought, was for all. It was truly catholic. He did not set up a sect, a 'denomination'. He invited people into love and this love must be shared. Love must love. The Catholic school is missioned and must be for other. It is about education for all. It must essentially be open to all. It must be that and appear to be that. Anything that smacks of the private, the elite, the sect is naturally abhorrent to the one who has been loved by the one Yahweh, and called to love and minister to the 'whole of creation'.

This has all sorts of implications for the way integration is being implemented and there must be a continual search for new answers to ensure that the operation of the Catholic schools, as integrated schools, does not cut across the very nature of the schools.

I believe that the Catholic school has a unique opportunity to bring the Good News into the lives of the people involved in it. I believe that if the school can have the courage to keep searching for meaning, searching for answers to the changing questions that arise with each generation, supporting each unique personal search

of the sacred human beings that come into its orbit, then it has enormous value in the Church.

In this our jubilee year, it is well to reflect on how we have sought to be a Catholic school in terms of what I have said. I believe there is much to consider which gives cause for joy and hope. I would be unrealistic to think that there is not cause examine some aspects. Nevertheless, there have been signs this year of the continued growth of that approach to individuals which I believe truly reflect the Good News. We have sought as an integrated Catholic school, to be true to the call of the Church, to be open to the needs of the boys and to meet those needs. Behind all the words, which are necessary to help us clarify what we are seeking to do, there is a very genuine concern for individual boys and, I believe, that concern has manifest itself in tangible ways which help people here to be aware of just how precious they are. There is cause for great hope that we as a college can continue to move towards the ideal of being a truly Catholic college. A place where there is an environment of love that is open to the sacred, and so believes in people and in the world, in the truth and our ability to grow into the truth in every way.

At the end of our jubilee year, I thank those people who have worked so hard in the course of the year to move a step closer to that ideal. I also thank those who had the courage to hold onto the original vision and work over the past twenty five years to establish and preserve this college. For us who have inherited it, the challenge is to work to centre it more and more on Christ so that the people involved here may grow in their awareness of just how precious they are. I would ask you all to pray that we may be open to the guidance of God's Spirit in doing this.

As we approach the Christmas season, when we celebrate Jesus coming among us, I pray that you may all come to see that in Jesus, God has called us to himself and in this awareness, may you experience the peace and joy that comes from him.



The major expenditures by the P.T.A. on


your behalf were:






